## CRUMP & TRASSO EARN WEEKLY WRESTLING HONORS

Providence, R.I.—Rhode Island College sophomore 174 lbs. **Caleb Crump (Tucson, AZ)** was named the New England Wrestling Association (NEWA) Rookie of the Week, while senior 149 lbs. **Mike Trasso (Lyndhurst, NJ)** was named the Pilgrim League Wrestler of the Week, for their respective performances at a quad-match hosted by Bridgewater State on Saturday, Feb. 11.

Crump picked up his third NEWA Rookie of the Week honor this season after going 3-0 last weekend. He defeated BSU's Ryan Cassidy, 7-1, pinned Coast Guard's Vaughn Gehman at 2:16 and won, 6-2, over Trinity's Kyle Muir.

He has won five straight matches and is 20-12 with 47 takedowns, four reversals, 16 escapes, 11 near-falls and eight pins.

Trasso earned his second Pilgrim League award on the season after winning two matches on Saturday. He defeated Mike Giorgio from Coast Guard, 6-2, and pinned Trinity's Thomas Crabtree at 2:03.

For the season, he is 19-5 with 46 takedowns, three reversals, 12 escapes, seven near-falls and two pins.
